## Homework guidelines

Please note that this is only a guideline; and that time will vary depending on projects, tests, end of term, school breaks as well as individual academic strengths. Homework assigned on weekends and holidays can vary and be flexible, depending on the teacher and grade level.

The French or English reading assignement is included in the time allotment at all levels. Helping a student to form good reading habits requires support from home. Studies have shown that reading to or with a student of any age significantly benefits the student's reading development.

## Kindergarten :

Reading 5 minutes \& vocabulary 5 minutes for a total of $\mathbf{1 0}$ minutes per night.

## Cycle One : Grade 1 and 2

Reading per night 10 minutes \& vocabulary and lessons per night 10-20 minutes for a total of 20-30 minutes per night.

## Cycle Two: Grade 3 and 4

Reading per night 20 minutes ( 10 min . in each language) and homework for1525 minutes for a total of $35-45$ minutes per night.

## Cycle Three: Grade 5 and 6

Reading per night 15 minutes ( one language per night) and homework 45-60 minutes for a total of 60-75 minutes per night.

If your child is consistently spending a higher amount of time on homework than the recommended guidline, you need let your child's teacher know.
